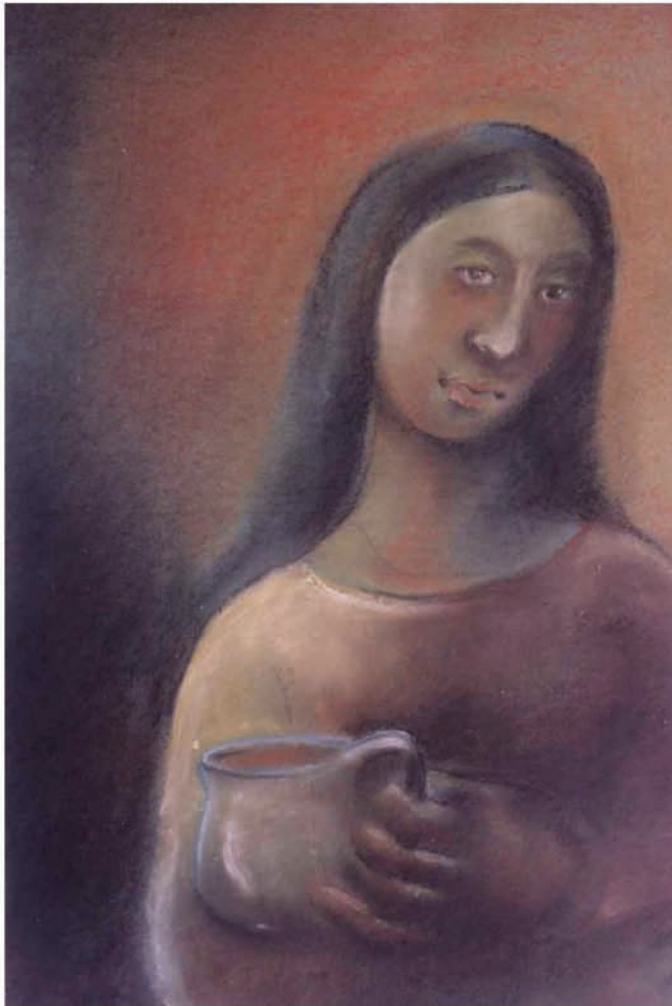

In her second solo exhibition, Madhabi Katoch presents a series of soft pastel paintings capturing those fleeting moments which give life its flavour. The series is divided into three categories: Silent Thoughts, Intimate Moments and Friendship/ Togetherness.

Madhabi has a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts from the College of Art, New Delhi. She has been awarded the United Nations Fellowship and Silver Medal in her final year. She also has a post graduate degree in History of Art from the National Museum Institute, New Delhi and has been awarded a research grant scholarship of 1994-95 for the Indian Collection at the Victoria Albert Museum, England, by the Nehru Trust.



Previous exhibitions include 'Vignettes of Ladakh' in May 2000 held at Lalit Kala Academy. Annual exhibitions at the College of Art, New Delhi 1992-98; Yuva Mahotsav 1989-92 and an exhibition cum demonstration of Glass Painting in 1993. Madhabi has been a visiting lecturer at the College of Art, New Delhi 1995-98; South Delhi Women's Polytechnic 1995-98 and the Institute of Fashion Technology, Lucknow in 1999.
